Close your eyes and imagine for a moment that you could not read this letter, watch TV or see your children grow up due to vision loss. How would you make your coffee in the morning, shop for groceries or handle an emergency? What if you had a child born with vision impairment?

Where could you go for the help and support you would need? The Vision Rehabilitation Center of the Ozarks (VRCO) is here to meet those needs and many others that people with vision loss face every day.

VRCO provides services to people of all ages regardless of their ability to pay. The latest technologies for low vision care are expensive and not covered by insurance. Patients face great challenges completing daily activities without proper vision care and assistive devices. Since opening its doors in 2010, VRCO has helped over 1700 people maintain independence through specialized vision care and the use of adaptive technology. VRCO has worked with more than 100 children, ages birth to three, and their families learn how to do things like explore their environment safely, prepare them for using braille, and transition into the school system.

Founded by Mercy Eye Specialists, VRCO is a 501(c) (3) organization that is operated through private donations, local grants, and insurance reimbursement. Community partners include Abilities First, Delta Gamma Alumnae, Drury University, Lions Clubs of District 26, Mattax Neu Prater, Mercy Health System, and Missouri State University.

It is through the continued support of the community that we are able to help improve the quality of life for people with vision impairments. We invite you to partner with us for the 13th Annual Memorial Sight Saving Scramble Golf Tournament.
